- 6 person / 1 vehicle / 2 tent limit per vehicle camp site.
- \$6 for a 2<sup>nd</sup> vehicle, if site allows
- 4 person / 1 tent limit per primitive camp site ( 1 vehicle maximum )
- 7 night maximum stay.
- 30 ft. limit for RV's and trucks with trailers. Sites are limited.

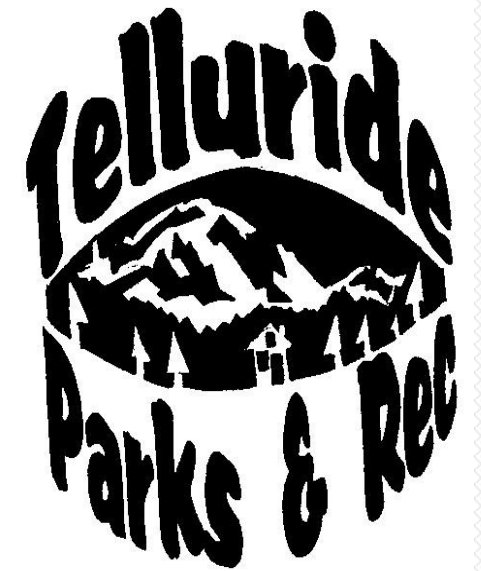
### BEAR CREEK RANGER ACTIVITIES
