

Telluride Town Park Rules

PLEASE, NO:

Wood Fires

Hitting golf balls

Glass containers

Horses or livestock

Unauthorized vending

Unauthorized advertising

Metal detecting or digging

Smoking within 15 feet of Public Buildings

Hunting, firearms, pellet/paint guns, or archery

Dogs inside Public Buildings (service dogs are allowed)

Pets must be on leash and may not be left unattended (fines apply)

Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets (fines apply)

Only authorized motorized vehicles on pathways

Please recycle aluminum and plastic in proper containers

All sports participants are subject to disciplinary action for violation of the coach / parent / player code of conduct

More specific rules are posted at the following Park facilities:
Skatepark, Bike Pump Track, Pavilion, and Pool

Park curfew: October - April (9:00pm) and May – September (10:00pm)

Lawful use and possession of alcohol under the Telluride Municipal Code is limited by Ordinance #1379 to between 10:00 am & 10:00 pm, if the person is:

- A participant or spectator at scheduled adult (not youth) recreational programs,
- Attending a private function scheduled with the permission of the Town,
- A guest registered at any campsite located within the Town Park Campground, or
- Attending a special event which is scheduled with the permission of the Town and has obtained a Special Event Permit through the State of Colorado.

Use and possession of alcohol is prohibited anytime at the Skatepark, the Town Park Pool, and within any structure in Town Park (excluding the Town Park Pavilion)
