



What You Need to Know About Alcohol Beverages In Telluride

- ✓ Public consumption of alcohol is allowed only in designated communal dining areas on Colorado Avenue and in the Spruce Street and Oak Street pocket parks, and only alcohol purchased from a restaurant or bar licensed to sell takeout alcohol beverages is allowed in these areas.
- ✓ Alcohol consumption in communal dining areas and pocket parks is allowed between 10:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.
- ✓ Takeout alcohol sales are permitted *only with the purchase of food*.
- ✓ Takeout alcohol orders must be made in-person, by phone, or via the internet.
- ✓ Takeout alcohol orders must be picked up at the restaurant or bar by the paying customer who must verify upon pickup they are of legal age. (Patrons may be requested to momentarily remove masks.)
- ✓ Food and alcohol purchases must be reflected on the same transaction receipt.
- ✓ Takeout alcohol must be sold in sealed containers or in cups closed securely with a lid taped to the cup and covering any holes in the lid.
- ✓ Takeout containers must include the required State of Colorado warning label.
- ✗ Servers may NOT take orders for alcohol from communal dining areas or pocket parks.
- ✗ Servers may NOT deliver alcohol beverages.
- ✗ Alcohol may NOT be consumed on sidewalks or anywhere in public except in Town designated communal dining areas or pocket parks; beverages must remain sealed while in transit.
- ✗ Alcohol may NOT be purchased for takeout without the purchase of food.
- ✗ Refilling of cups or containers is NOT permitted.
